- 2. Enclose your marked ballot in an envelope and seal.
- **3. Print** your name, **sign** and **date** the envelope. This can be signed by any one of the individuals on an account.
- 4. Return to the credit union no later than March 21st, 2025.
- Your ballot will be kept confidential. Member verification is a legal requirement that permits the Nominating Committee to validate membership. Unnamed, unsigned ballots cannot be counted.
- Voting is limited to members or joint owners, age 18 or over, that are members of record as of December 31, 2024. Only one vote per account. You may enter one ballot for each primary social security number,
